Registration Terms and Conditions

Acceptance

Pupils are accepted into Suffolk Academy of Dance & Performing Arts on the understanding that they comply with the terms and conditions set out below. Suffolk Academy prides itself on its friendly, non-competitive atmosphere. All students are expected to work hard and show respect for their fellow students, teachers and surroundings. The principal reserves the right to request a student to leave the academy if their behaviour is inappropriate or unacceptable at any time.

The placing of a student into the appropriate class is at the discretion of the principal, being based on age and ability. If at any time it is felt by the teachers that the student would benefit from changing classes, then this will be discussed with the parents.

Fees

Fees are paid for the classes that the student attends. Any extra activities that may arise will be optional and charged at the appropriate rate.

Fees are payable every 6 weeks, in advance. A notice will go on the notice board the week before they are due, the week they are due and the following week. The dates they are due will also be available on the website. Payment can be made by cash or cheque made payable to SADPA.

Please ensure that payment is in an envelope clearly marked with the student's name.

Fees which are not paid on time will be subjected to a 10% late payment charge.

Examinations

Examinations are optional but all students are encouraged to take them so that they are able to see the progress they are making and feel proud of their achievements. Letters will be issued in advance of examinations detailing times and fees. Any fees not received by the date stated will result in the student being withdrawn from the examination.

Shows

During shows students are looked after by chaperones. These are all licensed by Suffolk County Council and are CRB checked. The chaperones are all volunteers (mostly parents).

Uniform

Correct uniform is required for ALL classes.

Girls must wear their hair up for all classes and it must be in a bun for all ballet classes, including Pom Poms.

Little Stars – black ballet shoes, black leggings, SADPA t-shirt.

Girls - Pom Poms – pink leotard with skirt attached with BBO logo, pink ballet socks or tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes.

Sequins and Diamonds – purple leotard, pink ballet socks or tights, tan tights, pink ballet shoes, black tap shoes, black jazz shoes. Black leggings or shorts may be worn for tap and modern.

Sparkles and Dazzlers – Black cami leotard, tan tights, ballet tights, pink ballet shoes, “applause” tap shoes, black jazz shoes.

Street – black leggings/tracksuit bottoms, SADPA t-shirt, black jazz shoes.

Boys - All classes except street – black ballet shoes, black jazz shoes, black tap shoes, black leggings, white vest top or SADPA class t-shirt.

Street – black leggings/tracksuit bottoms, SADPA t-shirt, black jazz shoes.

All ballet shoes up to grade 1 must have elastic on and from then on girls must have ribbons

SADPA t-shirts may be worn for tap and modern and classes at the discretion of the teacher.

Uniform can be ordered through the Academy. Forms can be downloaded from the website (sadpa.co.uk).

Payment must be made with orders. (Cash or Cheque payable to SADPA). All leotards must be ordered through the Academy to ensure that everybody has the correct style.

Coming to class

Students with asthma must ensure they have their inhalers with them.

The notice board is a very important method of communication; please ensure you check it each week. Parents are not permitted to watch classes.

If any details that you give on the registration form change please ensure that you inform the Academy.
